Dr. Hallowell earned his Ph.D. from Oregon State University, with a dual focus in Construction Engineering and Management and Occupational Safety and Health. In addition to his role as a the Beaver's Endowed Professor of Construction Engineering, Dr. Hallowell holds an appointment in the Department of Environmental and Occupational Health at the University of Colorado Medical Center and an Honorary Professorship at the Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology. He conducts research in construction safety, specializing in injury prevention strategies, predictive analytics for safety, precursor analysis, leading indicators, hazard recognition, and safety risk management. He is the recipient of the National Science Foundation CAREER Award, the Construction Industry Institute's Outstanding Researcher Award, and the American Society of Civil Engineers' Excellence in Civil Engineering Education Award.

Prior to his academic career, Dr. Hallowell worked as a laborer for Fenderson-Howe Builders, Project Engineer for Pine Tree Engineering, Engineering and Construction Manager for Penn Lyon Homes, and President of Modular Design Solutions. Matthew provides consultation for construction safety, focusing on fatality prevention.
